利庫德集團部長：應當藉著黎巴嫩的選舉來解除真主黨的武裝：

交通部長以色列.卡茨（利庫德）說應當藉著真主黨在上禮拜天黎巴嫩議會選舉中的失敗，解除真主黨的武裝。以色列外交部長對這選舉的回應是「黎巴嫩政府應當以行動來鞏固國家的安全，阻止武器被偷運進入黎巴嫩境內 - 施行相關的安全措施。」2006年，聯合國安理會的停火決議終止了第二次的以黎戰爭，當中規定了必須解除國外的軍火武裝。但這項命令從未被實行。真主黨的背後有伊朗支持，又從敘利亞不斷運入軍火武器，現今的真主黨有著三倍於之前儲備的飛彈，以色列是他們要射向的目標。（Arutz 7）

哈理理再次擔保真主黨

資深黎巴嫩政壇人物薩德·哈理理已經告知美國的新聞工作者，新選出的國會議員多數並不計畫與以色列和平對話。在親西方集團與敘利亞所支持的真主黨對抗的戰役中獲勝後，哈理理被看作是最有希望成為下任黎巴嫩總理的人選。哈理理也竭力要使他親西方的身分能被降溫。他說：「這次選舉是要處理關於黎巴嫩內部的事務，而不是這個國家與西方或與敘利亞和伊朗的關係。」真主黨表示決心維持它目前在政府中的影響力，並保持它私有的軍隊以及儲備的軍火。（INN）

巴拉克：我們不喜歡美軍提供武器給黎巴嫩

以色列國防部長埃胡德·巴拉克於6/9（二）表示以色列【不喜歡】美國在最近幾個月供應黎巴嫩武器的事實，還承諾了他們的領袖，將要供應更多的軍火給他們。巴拉克警告說：「這些武器可能進到真主黨的手中。」黎巴嫩的國防部長埃利亞·穆爾揭露說，「上個月美副總統拜登承諾無論選舉結果如何，都要供應42個戰鬥機與直升機、無人駕駛飛機和坦克。」（INN）

以色列告訴密契爾定居點的自然增長不會停止

以色列定居點的建造問題，當6/9（禮拜二）美國的中東特使密契爾與以色列領袖會面時，以色列長期建造的社區定居點允許自然增長建設，一直是爭論的源頭。密契爾在與納坦雅胡會面的四小時中，得知即使這是美國所聲明的立場，以色列也不會將所有定居點的建造工程停止下來。

以色列堅持不能阻止家庭的增長或是攔阻孩子們結婚而產生對房屋的需求，另外，美國國務卿希拉蕊·柯林頓說歐巴馬政府並不承認前美國總統小布希在一封信上對以色列的承諾，那承諾是有大量人口的市中心不會被納進入未來的巴勒斯坦國中。

美國對以色列施壓，要求重開迦薩走廊通道：

以色列的外交安全內閣於週三上午討論是否重開迦薩走廊的通道。美國提出重開迦薩走廊通道的提案，必須要在監督的機器能夠監測貨物進入哈馬斯領土的狀況下。迦薩走廊通道的未來，將會是美國中東特使密契爾與以色列間會談的一個重點。（Ha' aretz）

哈馬斯的恐怖攻擊行動受挫：

禮拜日，十名槍手在卡爾尼裝載貨物要進入迦薩時上演了一場失敗的攻擊，這些馬匹被用來裝滿炸藥。在接著與以色列國防軍交火中，至少有四名恐怖份子與幾匹馬被打死。以色列士兵都沒受傷。以實麥爾·哈尼耶（負責迦薩哈馬斯恐怖政府）稱讚這些攻擊者為「烈士」且說暴力證實以色列對哈馬斯的「侵略意圖」。以色列國防軍中校雅比諾目·斯拓來比奇說，將來這一類的攻擊會使哈馬斯將自己處於第二次鑄鉛行動的危險中。（J.Post）

這是另一個最新免於重大恐怖攻擊的例子，為什麼以色列絕不能容許美國施壓而開啟以色列國防軍管理的路障與檢查站。拆除路障會帶來真正的危險，讓恐怖分子將武器偷運進入以色列，造成無辜的以色列民受傷或死亡。

請繼續禱告美國與其他西方國家能明白，為何這些路障必須設立在那兒，並施行檢查。同時也為以色列有智慧來決定該如何更好的安排這些路障與檢查站禱告。

哈馬斯將46輛救護車改裝成軍用車，救援物資遭到不當使用：

巴勒斯坦的保健部長於禮拜二說，哈馬斯恐怖集團的成員劫掠了46輛救護車（最近由阿拉伯國家捐獻，要作為醫療設備），並將它們塗黑，作為軍用車輛。一位部門主管要求哈馬斯公開聲明，在這數千噸的醫療器材中，有多少被送進迦薩走廊作為援助巴勒斯坦人民之用，又有多少沒有發放出去，而被送往私人的倉庫與私有的醫療中心，再轉賣給毫無能力的民眾。（PMW）

部長：以色列有10.5%的公司今年將要關閉

工業、貿易與勞工部長本-埃利澤這禮拜警告說，以色列一些小型企業將面臨關閉的危機。他說超過四萬七千個企業預計將在2009年關閉。他提出了從他部門蒐集得出的嚴峻數字，是依照目前的環境，並加上85% 預估將會關閉的個人經營企業。他更進一步的警告這全球危機預期將會引致大約一萬三千個工作機會的減少。若是這危機繼續，他預計這數字還會更高。（YNET）

LIKUD MINISTER: USE LEBANESE VOTE TO DISARM HIZBULLAH:

Transport Minister Yisrael Katz (Likud) said Hizbullah's defeat in Sunday's legislative elections in Lebanon should be used to disarm the terrorist organization. The Israel Foreign Ministry responded to the election results by stating "the government of Lebanon must act to strengthen the country's stability and to stop arms smuggling into its territory - and to implement the relevant Security Council resolutions." The UN Security Council ceasefire resolution that ended the Second Lebanon War in 2006 stipulated that "foreign armies" would be disarmed, but the mandate never was carried out. Hizbullah, which is sponsored by Iran and is supplied with weapons from Syria, has more than tripled its former stockpile of rockets aimed at Israel. (Arutz 7)

HARIRI REASSURES HIZBULLAH: Senior Lebanese politician Saad Hariri has informed US journalists the newly elected majority does not plan peace talks with Israel. Hariri is seen as a favorite for the position of Prime Minister following the victory of relatively pro-Western parties in Lebanon over the pro-Syrian bloc led by Hizbullah. Hariri also sought to cool enthusiasm over the perceived "pro-Western" status of the elected majority. "The elections were about internal Lebanese affairs and not about the country's ties with the West or with Syria and Iran," he said. Hizbullah expressed determination to maintain its current influence in the government and to retain its private army and weapons stockpile. (INN)

BARAK: WE DON'T LIKE THE US ARMING OF LEBANON: Defense Minister Ehud Barak said Tuesday that Israel "does not like" the fact the US has been supplying arms to Lebanon in recent months and has promised its leaders further munitions in coming days. "These weapons could reach Hizbullah," he warned. Lebanese Defense Minister Elias Murr revealed last month that US Vice President Biden promised to provide the Lebanese army with 42 fighter jets as well as helicopters, UAVs and tanks, regardless of election results. ISRAEL TELLS MITCHELL NATURAL GROWTH WON'T HALT: The settlement construction issue, which allows for natural growth development in Israel's long established settlement communities, continued to be a source of contention when US envoy George Mitchell met with Israel's leaders on Tuesday. Mitchell, during a four hour meeting with PM Binyamin Netanyahu, was told Israel would not bring all settlement construction to a complete halt, even though this continues to be the US's

stated position. Israel maintains it cannot stop families from growing and prevent their children from marrying and needing homes of their own. In addition, US Secretary of State Hillary Clinton has said the Obama government will not honor a promise in a letter to Israel by former President George W. Bush that the large population centers would not be included in a future PA country. US PRESSURES ISRAEL TO REOPEN GAZA CROSSINGS: Israel’s diplomatic-security cabinet convened on Wednesday morning to discuss the opening of crossings into the Gaza Strip. It is expected to adopt a US proposal to allow for the crossings to open solely on condition that a supervising mechanism can be in place to monitor the goods that enter the Hamas-ruled territory. The future of the Gaza crossings was a focus of talks between US Middle East envoy George Mitchell and the Israeli leadership. (Ha’aretz) ***“You are awesome, O God, in your sanctuary. FOILED GAZA TERRORIST ATTACK: Ten gunmen staged a failed assault at the Karni cargo crossing into Gaza on Monday, in which horses laden with explosives were used. At least four terrorists and a number of their horses were killed in the ensuing exchange of fire with the IDF. No soldiers were wounded. Ismail Haniyeh, who heads Gaza's Hamas terrorist government, praised the attackers as "martyrs," and said the violence confirmed Israel's "aggressive intentions" toward the Palestinians. IDF Lt.-Col. Avinoam Stolevitch said future assaults of this sort would put Hamas at risk of a second Operation Cast Lead. (J.Post) **This most recently averted major terrorist attack is another example of why Israel must not allow US pressure to force the opening of IDF operated roadblocks and crossings. There is a real danger that dismantling roadblocks will only enable terrorists to smuggle weapons into Israel which could injure or kill innocent civilians. Please continue to pray for understanding in the US and other Western nations as to why these roadblocks have been set up and enforced - and for Israel’s wisdom in removing or maintaining them in the future.**

HAMAS CONVERTS 46 AMBULANCES TO MILITARY VEHICLES, MISUSING AID: The Palestinian Health Ministry stated Tuesday that members of the Hamas terrorist group had raided 46 ambulances, recently donated by Arab states, of the medical equipment they contained. They then used them as military vehicles after painting them black. A ministry director demanded that Hamas declare openly what had become of the thousands of tons of medical equipment brought into the Gaza Strip as assistance for the Palestinian people, and which had passed at its orders to private warehouses and its own medical centers, then was later sold to helpless citizens. (PMW)

MINISTER; 10.5% OF ISRAEL’S BUSINESSES TO CLOSE THIS YEAR: Industry, Trade and Labor Minister Ben-Eliezer this week warned of the collapse of small businesses in Israel. He said over 47,000 businesses are expected to shut down in 2009. He presented grim figures compiled by his ministry on the situation and added

that about 85% of the businesses expected to close are self-employed businesses. He further warned the global crisis is expected to lead to a loss of some 13,000 jobs this year. If the crisis continues, he estimated, the figures presented will be bigger. (Ynet)

JELLYFISH HEAD TO ISRAEL'S COASTS: Jellyfish will hit Israel's coasts in large numbers during the summer months, Magen David Adom said Monday. The MDA suggests bathers take a small bottle of vinegar to the beach with them, as this can help in alleviating the pain if stung by a jellyfish. (J.POST)
